Bayonet for a Littich cavalry rifle, Model 1848, with a fluted grip and bronze guard numbered "331", the steel blade marked with the maker's mark "PJ MALHERBE À LIÈGE". Belgian manufacture for Russia, second half of the 19th century. Blade length 55 cm. Overall length 67 cm. History: This bayonet, manufactured in Liège by FJ Malherbe for the Tsar of Russia, is an example of military history and high-quality craftsmanship. It is designed for use with a Littich cavalry rifle. This bayonet exemplifies Russia's ability to produce superior weapons abroad, which was crucial to its military expansion and global influence.
