A very fashionable piece of furniture in England at that time, it offers five levels of storage. This large model consists of a base with a low plinth and a molded cornice at the top. The five storage compartments close with sliding glass panels. A large bookcase with a lot of character, a somewhat atypical piece of furniture in France. The glass panels slide inside the cabinet, which is very original and allows for significant storage, with the glass revealing decorative objects and other items through the transparency. Maintenance is minimal, and one of the glass panes has been replaced.
