RARE DECREE OF THE COUP D'ÉTAT OF 18 BRUMAIRE YEAR VIII (SATURDAY 9 NOVEMBER 1799) ORGANIZED BY EMMANUEL-JOSEPH SIEYÉS AND EXECUTED BY NAPOLEON BONAPARTE WITH THE DECISIVE AID OF HIS BROTHER LUCIEN, MARKS THE END OF THE DIRECTORY AND THE FRENCH REVOLUTION AND THE BEGINNING OF THE CONSULATE. WHILE THE DECISIVE EVENTS OCCURRED ON 19 BRUMAIRE AT THE CHÂTEAU DE SAINT CLOUD WHERE THE COUNCIL OF FIVE HUNDRED AND THE COUNCIL OF ELDERLY MET, IT WAS ON THE 18TH THAT THE CONJURY PUT IN PLACE THE NECESSARY ELEMENTS OF THE PLOT.
