Note: Georges Clemenceau (1841-1929), French statesman, nicknamed "The Tiger," played a decisive role during the First World War, leading the country to victory and participating in the Treaty of Versailles. A symbol of authority and determination. Dimensions: 6.5 cm (handle), 89.5 cm (total). Made in England for the French market, made at the early of the 20th century.
