Description

A superb and rare sculptural floor lamp created by American designer Neal Small in the 1960s, made entirely of white acrylic. The piece consists of two acrylic panels, each with a half-globe from which the light emanates. The panels are joined by four chrome screws. When lit, the lamp emits a warm, diffused light that highlights its fluid geometry, inspired by the space age--an iconic aesthetic signature of Small's work. This piece, along with three others designed by Small, is in the collection of MoMA. In excellent condition, with only a few minor scratches on the base, the wiring has been updated. Small has been named the Prince of Plastic by the New-York Times.
