An elegant Edwardian rectangular cluster panel ring, crafted in 18ct yellow gold with a platinum-set panel. The ring is pavé set with twelve eight-cut diamonds, framed within a rectangular cluster, while each raised shoulder is accented with two tiny rose-cut diamonds for added sparkle. The diamonds are assessed as approximately $12 \times 0.05\text{ct}$ and $4 \times 0.01\text{ct}$, giving an estimated total diamond weight of 0.64 carats. The shank is stamped 18ct & Plat.
