Menuki in brass representing the Ryu dragon. Tsuba Mokko Gata in copper covered with shakudo, chiselled with the Ryu dragon in a stormy sea, the whole enhanced with gold; signed. Fuchi and Kashira decorated as a set. Seppa in gilded and chiselled copper. Wakizashi with Shinogi Tsukuri blade, Mune Hikushi, Notare-style Hamon. O Maru-style Boshi. Nakago Funa Gata and Kiri or Kaku Ichi Monki, signed Kaniyasu (??). Daitsuki-niju-habaki in gilded copper. Saya in wood covered with black lacquer with fluting. Kojiri, Kuri Gata and Koi Guchi in lacquered buffalo horn. Shitodome in chiselled brass. Sageo in black and brown braided silk. Kogatana with Kotsuka in chiselled shakudo depicting the dragon Ryu holding a sceptre, flying through the clouds, all enhanced with gold; signed blade. Tsuka ito made of wood, covered with shagreen, braided with white silk. Menuki made of brass representing the dragon Ryu. Tsuba Mokko Gata made of copper covered with shakudo, chiselled with the dragon Ryu in a stormy sea, the whole enhanced with gold; signed. Fuchi and Kashira decorated as a set; signed.
