des Beaux-Arts. He studied there for three years. He studied under Cormon and Laurens, the two great masters of history painting. Called up for military service, he completed his service as a musician in 1913. But on August 2, 1914, he was sent as a stretcher-bearer to the 1st Engineer Regiment, 22nd Company. He remained in this position throughout the war.
