### Description

A beautiful pair of polychrome mosaic tiles, made in the early 20th century. Each panel is composed of finely fitted colored tesserae, forming a stylized floral motif inspired by Art Nouveau and the historicist decorative styles of the late 19th century. The composition is centered on a large, symmetrical, scrolling plant motif, enhanced with vibrant hues of blue, green, pink, yellow, and ochre. The whole is framed by a geometric border of white tesserae, creating an elegant contrast with the gold and brown background. A very high-quality decorative work, ideal for architectural integration, wall decoration, or display as a picture. Period: Early 20th century (circa 1900-1920) Technique: Mosaic in glass paste and/or earthenware tesserae Motifs: Stylized, symmetrical floral decoration
