### Description

A beautiful set of 12 chrome-plated metal knife rests. Chrome offers excellent wear resistance. Furthermore, the steel or stainless steel blades of the knives perfectly complement the gray tone of the rests. The aesthetic appeal of this set lies in its avoidance of simply copying Sandoz's Gallia set by introducing several new animals. It is, however, very clever to have retained the proportions and poses of the originals, unlike other sets that feature long-legged and often emaciated subjects. This set comprises: a peacock, a dove, a hen, a grasshopper, a rhinoceros, a lion, a dog, a panther, a monkey, a sea lion, an elephant, and a fish. The monkey and the sea lion have their heads raised, which lightens their silhouette, and the appearance of the grasshopper on its long legs and the elephant with its trunk
