Made of walnut and mahogany, it features finely sculpted and moulded legs, with graceful, flowing lines reminiscent of the organic forms so dear to the artist. The top and the back panel are beautifully inlaid with lacustrine landscape marquetry, showcasing exceptional craftsmanship and a masterful command of wood veneers. The desktop includes a drawer fitted with its original key, and Majorelle's signature appears on the right side of the drawer front, serving as a discreet mark of authenticity. The ensemble is completed by a patinated leather writing surface
