Yuzen-Birodo technique was invented by Nishimura Sozaemon of Kyoto in 1868. The velvet was woven by passing threads through fine metal wires parallel to the weft, then cut to form the pile. The precise cutting allowed for a three-dimensional effect. Good condition, slight signs of wear. Framed under glass. Free shipping within the European Union!
