Note: Tiffany & Co., an American jewelry company founded by Charles Lewis Tiffany (father of Louis Comfort Tiffany) and John Barnett Young in 1837 in New York, has specialized in jewelry and diamonds in particular since Charles L. Tiffany, nicknamed "the Diamond King," bought back jewels from the French crown jewels sold in 1887 by the French Third Republic. In 2017, Lady Gaga became the brand's new ambassador. Tiffany, a house of excellence, was acquired by LVMH in January 2021. Carefully packaged, shipped with declared value.
