The central backrest is finely openwork with scroll motifs, which are also found on the rails beneath the seat. Straight legs, connected by stretchers, ensure balance and elegance. An attractive patina underscores their authentic character and decorative appeal. A refined example of high-end Chinese seating furniture from the Qing dynasty, combining the tradition of the Ming style with 19th-century decorative taste.
