A painted limestone statue of a bishop, seated on a throne, dating from the 17th century at the latest, or very likely from an earlier period. It can certainly be attributed to Dutch, Belgian, or German craftsmanship. The bishop, enthroned on a bench, wears an episcopal mitre, a chasuble fitted at the front that stops just below the knees, and beneath it, an alb that reaches the ground.
