It has a beautiful original patina, including the original bronze knobs and keyhole escutcheons. It has been fully restored in our workshop, but to be honest, there is virtually no restoration at all! It is in pristine condition and has only undergone a preventative treatment with Xylophene and has been waxed several times to achieve a beautiful
