Description

Art Deco pendant chandelier by Degué and Marcel Vasseur. Large, highly textured sphere, approximately 23 cm in diameter, with a geometric design in molded and pressed satin-matte glass with a glossy relief, by Degué. Superb hand-hammered wrought iron frame with an anthracite patina and its three original large hammered clamping balls, the work of the renowned wrought iron craftsman Marcel Vasseur, who exhibited at the 1925 International Exhibition of Decorative Arts in Paris. There, he created all the ironwork for the Pavillon de la Maîtrise, the Galeries Lafayette Art Workshop (FAG), directed by Maurice Dufrène. The chain consists of three elongated, round rings, each over 10 cm long. The canopy is made of smooth iron, likely replaced. Circa 1925-1930. Rewired.
