This piece of furniture is not only functional but represents a true work of popular carpentry and carving. Material: High-quality Solid Oak. Period: Late 18th Century (c. 1780-1800). Features: The structure stands on four carved, tapering legs. The central body features panels with rich and complex figurative bas-relief carvings, likely depicting religious, allegorical, or rural life scenes typical of the popular art of the era. The upper section is fitted with a slanted hinged lid/top (or with two top doors) that traditionally functioned as a bread/storage bin
