A very pretty little Louis XVI style chair from the Napoleon III period, made of cream-colored lacquered wood. This charming chair rests on four fluted, tapered legs. The rounded apron is decorated all around with a ribboned frieze. The oval back with its openwork features the same motif as the apron. It is also adorned in its central section with a lovely "Montgolfier" motif. The top of the back is decorated with a pretty flattened, foliate bow. The seat is in very good condition, having been reupholstered quite recently; it is firm and very comfortable. The upholstery is an old rose velvet, but there are a few cat scratches on the front of the seat. It is clear that this chair has been repainted several times; indeed, some paint chips are visible. It also shows traces of old filling and wax. This chair
