A large pattern repeat of undulating ferns in a fine, tightly woven damask, playing on shades of old rose in a range of shades of lilac, powdery pink, and silver. Unused length from an unidentified Lyon manufacturer, which supplied the most famous houses of Worth, Doucet, Pingat, and Paquin! Perfect for a historical Art Deco or Art Nouveau decor.
