Abraham van Cuylenborch (Utrecht, 1620-1658) Bathers near a Cave with Classical Ruins On the back of the panel is a monogram "VS" Oil on panel, 60 x 84 cm Within a 19th-century frame. An artist to be counted among the followers of Poelenburgh, he devoted himself exclusively to the depiction of fantastical caves with arches that offer glimpses of a distant landscape, never failing to depict ancient sculptural elements, a sign of his contact with the picturesque ruinism that prevailed in Rome in the first half of the 17th century. Cuylenborch stayed in Rome and Florence between 1617 and 1625. Further replicas of the work are at the National Museum in Stockholm (Inv. 1599, panel, 60x84 cm) and already at the auction houses Bolaffi (Florence, 27 October 2022, Panel, 53x66.5 cm),
