The handle is carved from superb natural agate, with honey-brown and translucent gray hues, and magnificent internal veining typical of this semi-precious stone. The hilt is made of finely fitted silver, ensuring an elegant and solid transition between the blade and the handle. The whole offers a harmonious balance between the strength of the metal and the mineral softness of the agate. This knife was probably intended for refined table use or as a prestigious personal item.
