Description

Frock coat: a rare 18th-century frock coat attributed to Venice, made of beautiful plain green silk, adorned with floral motifs and interlacing patterns of exceptional braided gold thread, sein in relief, all harmoniously placed and distributed. These motifs can be admired on the front, the cuffs, the pocket flaps, the neckline, and the back, as well as on the long, flowing tails; the gold motifs are all in excellent condition. The silky fabric of the frock coat, a luminous green, shows some fading in places, but this does not detract from its exceptional character. Waistcoat: a waistcoat to wear under the frock coat or as loungewear, decorated on the front and neckline with floral motifs of silver thread and colored textiles; the waistcoat retains its 10 buttons covered in the same fabric. Breeches: black

Shirt: a new model added to the outfit, part of the collection shown. A set of fine decorative and/or collectible quality. Note: a repair to the back of the frock coat, one to the breeches; one button is missing from the front .Consolidation of antique stitching on the inner length of the sleeves This clothing set can be sold as a complete set of three pieces or possibly with the antique mannequin, as shown; in the latter case, the additional cost for the mannequin would be 300 euros.Dimensions: Shoulder width: 38 cm (frock coat) Frock coat height: 88 cm Total height of the mannequin: 132 cm
