The double drawer on the right in the lower section contains a chest and compartments. The desk top is crowned with Aleppo marble, encircled by an openwork gilt brass gallery. Beautiful and rich ornamentation in bronze and gilt brass, including keyhole escutcheons, drawer pulls, fluting, gallery, rings, sabots, moldings, and drawer and panel frames.
