Description

This style of cutlery is an example of the Arts & Crafts / Art Nouveau movements, specifically featuring a distinct thistle design at the terminal of the handles. The bowls of the spoons have a hammered finish, a common characteristic of the Arts & Crafts style, which emphasized handmade craftsmanship. Design Details Style: The organic, flowing design points to the Art Nouveau period, which flourished across Europe and the United States around the turn of the 20th century. Motif: The prominent feature of the handles appears to be the thistle, the national emblem of Scotland, which was a popular motif for Scottish silversmiths during this time. Finish: The hand-hammered texture (planished finish) on the spoon bowls and parts of the handle is characteristic of the Arts & Crafts
