Description

France, early 20th century. Terracotta Spaniel, numbered 818. Signed Thomas François Cartier on the base, with incised inscriptions: Made in France and Fontaine Paris. Engraved brass plaque: Spaniel Dog by Cartier. Capturing the precise moment when the hunting dog freezes, its eye fixed on its prey, this terracotta sculpture embodies all the nobility and elegance of the spaniel. Cartier, master animal sculptor, manages to render not only the muscular vigor and the fineness of the coat, but also the intensity of the pose: a work that breathes life, tension, and the beauty of movement. The warm patina of the terracotta, homogeneous and intact, gives the piece a rare depth and authenticity. Its state of preservation is perfect, without restoration or cracks, guaranteeing a piece ready to join a

discerning collection. The impressed markings "Made in France" and "Fontaine Paris" attest to its prestigious production, while the brass plaque adds a touch of refined presentation, worthy of elegant interiors or specialized collections.

Beyond its decorative appeal, this sculpture is a true celebration of early 20th-century French animal art. It will appeal to both hunting dog enthusiasts and art collectors, offering a strong and poetic presence in any space it inhabits. The piece is preserved in perfect condition, without restoration or cracks, with a uniform patina that highlights the richness of the terracotta. The brass plaque, discreetly affixed to the base, adds an extra dimension of presentation and authenticity.
