A small casket of music and memoryThere is a moment, when you lift the lid of this antique music box, in which time seems to pause. Light touches the ebony-stained wood, its fine golden lines, then falls across the glass that guards its delicate mechanism--a miniature world where gears and metal teeth awaken to tell stories from another age. Most likely crafted in France at the beginning of the 20th century, this music box preserves the refined, understated elegance of musical craftsmanship of the period. The illustrated label, miraculously intact, lists the six melodies engraved on the cylinder: famous opera arias, duets, and marches that fill the air one after another with a tone both clear and surprisingly alive. When the mechanism begins to turn, the sound travels through time: Aida, La Traviata, Il
