Description

Artist and Work Details Artist: Alan Wallwork (1931-2019) was a renowned British master potter known for his diverse and distinctive hand-built pottery and tiles. **Style:** His work often features a rough-hewn, sculptural, and organic aesthetic with earthy tones from matt glazes and oxides, as seen in the contrast between the white/grey and brown/terracotta areas of this piece. **Technique:** He frequently used incised textures and impressed decoration, often employing clay stamps and "roulettes," which is evident in the detailed geometric patterns on this vase. **Forms:** Wallwork was known for various forms including slab-built pieces, seed pods, and totem designs, which often conveyed a sense of ritual and mystery. The vase pictured is a classic example of his rectangular or slab form work
