This type of mule was highly prized in the 1920s and 1930s, both for bourgeois interiors and elegant outfits inspired by the Ottoman Orient, reflecting the fascination with exoticism in the decorative arts following the Colonial Exposition and the influence of designers like Paul Poiret.
