Originally designed to house a heating element for a cigarette lighter, it has been ingeniously converted into a decorative lamp. Its Edison-style bulb, combined with new wiring, allows it to regain its function while retaining its period charm. The geometric treatment of the reptile, the sculpted scales, and the deliberately graphic expression perfectly characterize the aesthetics of the 1920s and 30s. The original patina highlights the relief of the design, giving it a striking presence as a decorative piece or object of curiosity.
