Description

The print is mounted on its original card and bears the blind stamp of Alphonse Bernoud, a photographer active in Florence and Naples in the 1850s-1870s. Bernoud documented Italian cityscapes at a time when photography was becoming widespread in Europe, giving this view historical significance related to the city's development in the 19th century.
