A solid sterling silver centerpiece bowl, likely a bonbon or fruit dish, with a detailed hallmark confirming its origin. The piece features an ornate design with pierced fretwork and stands on a pedestal base. The hallmarks indicate that the item was made by the silversmith S.G. and was assayed in Birmingham, England, in the year 1902. The lion passant mark confirms the sterling silver standard, certifying a purity of 92.5%. The date letter "c" is consistent with the Birmingham Assay Office mark for the Edwardian year 1902.
