George III sterling silver sugar basket was made in London in 1795 by the silversmith Henry Chawner. Chawner was known for creating finely made tea ware and other silver items during the late 18th century, a period when he was an active plate worker and a member of the Goldsmiths' Company. The piece is characterized by its swing handle, delicately engraved decorative style, which is typical of the Georgian era.
