Handwoven using traditional Central Asian techniques, this rug offers a dense, supple, and durable texture, typical of hand-spun and hand-dyed wool. The multiple, richly decorated borders harmoniously frame the whole and emphasize the traditional character of the piece. Combining elegance, authenticity, and craftsmanship, this Bokhara rug is a decorative piece, ideal for both classic and contemporary
