Description

A bronze sculpture, in a very good condition, by Jean Bulio (1827-1911) represent "Venus and Cupidon". Venus, goddess of love, accompanied by Cupidon. This piece, typical of Bulio's academic and mythological style, measures approximately 48 cm in height. It is highly prized and sought after for its delicate rendering and the quality of its chasing. This sculpture is characteristic of the artist's work and has a medal patina. It is signed on the base with the Susse Frères foundry mark engraved on the back. Jean Bulio (1827-1911) was a French sculptor born in Fabrègues (Hérault) and died in Montpellier. Trained in Paris under Armand Toussaint, he later entered the École des Beaux-Arts. He is best known for his bronze sculptures, particularly busts and mythological figures (such as Venus
