Description

Delicate carved bone figure of Saint Sebastian, dating from the late 15th century (Late Gothic period). The saint is depicted in the traditional semi-nude pose, with the characteristic original small holes where separate arrows were once inserted--a common technique in German and Netherlandish workshops during the late Middle Ages.

The sculpture displays classic Gothic stylistic features: a softly modelled, expressive face, an elongated stylised anatomy, and drapery carved in V-shaped folds typical of the late 1400s. The bone has developed a natural patina over time, with light wear consistent with age. The flattened back suggests the piece originally belonged to a small domestic altar or portable altarpiece.
