The composition creates a harmonious contrast between the rigor of the worked metal and the satiny softness of the glass, in the spirit of the designers of the Nancy School and the French decorative workshops of the interwar period. The globe diffuses a soft, warm light, ideal for revealing the finesse of the decoration.
