Description

This oil painting on plywood panel is a spontaneous work, confidently executed. The steam tugboat, the center of attention, is docked in a harbor. In the background, sailboats and the contours of the coastline of a bay with substantial houses in mauve tones stand against an opalescent sky. The sea is a soft green, and the mooring bollard stands proudly on a paved quay. A typical work of the 1950s/60s, inspired by a rich atmosphere. A beautiful composition with colors worked in vigorous, thick brushstrokes. This panel is in its original frame, chosen by the artist, with a wide molding edged in patinated gold and a green border. The decorative ensemble is a beautiful asset, a distinctive seascape with a rich atmosphere, depicting an Atlantic port. The decorative painting, in soft tones, is in very good
