Description

An elegant abstract composition with surrealist influences, typical of Henri Nouveau's artistic explorations in the late 1940s. Against a finely textured beige background, the artist deploys a collection of geometric and biomorphic forms, floating freely in space. White lines delineate colored fragments--pinks, blues, greens, ochre, and black--creating a rhythmic, almost musical constellation. Without explicit narrative, the work evokes a suspended, mental scene where geometry and organic pulsations coexist. This combination, unique to Nouveau, places his language at the border of abstraction and surrealism, with a lightness and visual poetry characteristic of his mature period.
