Born in Tarragona in 1949, Jaume Queralt has always been intimately connected to drawing, a visceral passion nurtured since high school, which led him to forge his artistic vision within the prestigious art schools of Tarragona and Massana, and the mystical circle of Sant Lluc in Barcelona. Becoming a professional painter in 1972, his work is not simply a profession for him, but a fundamental need of the soul, a ceaseless exploration where each brushstroke is an attempt to transcend the ephemeral, to integrate his spirit into the work in order to reach a possible eternity. His vast and acclaimed career, spanning over half a century, is a torrent of creativity and intensity, manifested in an exceptional mastery of oil painting, collage, and printmaking, always within
