Carved and turned wood, crafted according to a highly elaborate architectural plan reminiscent of the aesthetics of grand 19th-century religious and civic buildings. Its impressive structure, composed of small columns, arches, pediments, and slender domes, testifies to remarkable craftsmanship and a pronounced taste for unique decorative works. Erected on its original base, also made of turned and molded wood, the aviary stands out as a true object of curiosity. Its airy and theatrical construction makes it an exceptional decorative piece, akin to the work of a master cabinetmaker or an ambitious piece of folk art. Features: Early 20th-century work. Carved, turned, and assembled wooden structure.
