Description

Marble Sculpture by Dante Zoi (active in the 19th century), Florence. This elegant marble sculpture depicts a graceful female figure captured in a restrained upward movement. The composition is distinguished by its balanced proportions, the fluidity of the drapery, and the precision of the pose, all characteristic of the 19th-century Florentine academic tradition. Carved from finely polished white marble, the work demonstrates a delicate modeling of the anatomy and a confident technical mastery. The drapery naturally follows the contours of the body and accentuates the sensation of lightness and movement, without disrupting the clarity of the composition. The finely sculpted face and the overall elegance of the figure reveal a profound artistic sensibility. The work is signed and engraved on the reverse
