Description

Ginori Manufactory, circa 1890 - Polychrome majolica, no. 390A refined polychrome majolica by the Ginori Manufactory, dating to around 1890. The piece features an elaborately crafted decorative structure, standing on a richly ornamented Neo-Renaissance style base. The upper portion showcases a finely modelled head with expressive features and a decorated headdress, a hallmark of Ginori's 19th-century works influenced by exoticism. The glazed majolica frame, painted in shades of blue, ochre, and gold, elegantly surrounds the figure, while hanging vegetal motifs--carefully shaped and painted--complete the composition. Numbered 390, this piece exemplifies the technical mastery and artistic sophistication achieved by the Tuscan manufactory in the late
