Description

The work captivates with the gentleness of its expression, the subtlety of its gaze, and the exquisite modeling of its face, rendered with great delicacy. The figure, dressed in a gown of muted, bluish tones, emerges from a nuanced background with soft harmonies, creating an intimate and elegant atmosphere. The presence of the palette and easel lends this portrait a particular dimension: it is an allegory or self-portrait of an artist, a relatively rare and sought-after theme, reflecting the growing recognition of women's role in artistic practice during this period. The brushwork is supple and controlled, with a limited and refined color
