Arch clock in chased and gilded bronze. The white enamelled dial is supported by a double arch in gilded bronze and topped with an eagle with outstretched wings. Gilded bronze base resting on four small skate feet. Original movement with revised silk thread escapement. Chimes on the hours and half hours. End of the Louis XVI period, circa 1790.
