The reverse of this cooler is decorated with a large fluted vase, the handles are in the shape of branches. Marked by the Fauquez manufacture in manganese below. Diameter: 18.5cm - Height: 17cm Eighteenth century Good condition, some points of cooking shrinkage, pierced with a hole in the bottom.
