In the 1920s and 1930s, they were widely used to create geometric patterns emblematic of the Art Deco style, often in combination with onyx, platinum, and diamonds. The setting beneath the stones is openwork. Very beautiful brilliance and exquisite craftsmanship. French work from the 1920s/1930s, hallmarked with a mascaron head (French hallmark for platinum).
