Description

Superb set of Louis XIV style silver-gilt spoons. The spoon bowls are decorated at the base with small gadroons evoking a shell; the front is engraved with a reserve of interlaced scrolls, acanthus leaves, and a shell on a matte background. On the reverse, the same type of ornamentation forms a blank cartouche. The stem with its fillet joins the bowl, which features the same gadrooned motif as the bowl. Each piece is hallmarked: Minerva 1st standard (pre-1973) for 950/1000 silver. Maker's mark: H & Cie with a rose branch and a star for Hénin et Compagnie, active from 1872 to 1974. Hénin et Compagnie was a renowned silversmith whose production was of such high quality that it was one of Odier's subcontractors, alongside other prestigious silversmiths like Granvigne and
