Description

Pierre Grivolos (1823-1906) "Herd of Goats on Mont Ventoux" Oil on canvas, Signed lower left. A beautiful work by the Avignon painter Pierre Grivolos depicting a herd of goats in a Provençal landscape. The scene most likely takes place in the vicinity of Mont Ventoux (Sault) in the Vaucluse region, where the artist regularly went to paint. A student of Ingres, Delacroix, and Flandrin, he exhibited at the Paris Salon between 1864 and 1882. A friend of the Félibrige poets, he dedicated himself to portraying Provençal and Comtat Venaissin traditions. In 1878, he was appointed director of the School of Fine Arts in Avignon, a position he held until his death in 1906. Considered the leading figure of the New Avignon School, he inspired many of his students, future artists, through his plein air
