A beautiful porcelain figurine from the Royal Copenhagen Manufactory depicting an emperor penguin protecting its chick, an iconic model in the company's animal repertoire. This piece bears the model number 088, one of Royal Copenhagen's most popular compositions, prized for the quality of its sculpting and the gentleness of its expression. The painting is particularly refined: subtle gradations of gray and white, a beautiful depth of expression in the eyes, and a highly naturalistic rendering of the chick's plumage and down. The reverse features the official mark of three waves, the royal crown, the inscription "Royal Copenhagen - Denmark," and the painter's initials (MR). The markings are free of scratches: a first-rate piece. A decorative and collectible work, typical of the golden age of
